### Chemist Interview Questions – For your practice before an interview

- Why did you apply for this job?
- Tell us something about your experience and research work.
- How do you imagine a typical day in work?
- What do you want to accomplish in this job? What are your goals?
- Are you a team player, or do you prefer to work on your own?
- Describe a situation when you reached a goal and tell us how you achieved it.
- Describe a time when you failed to reach the goal, and how you reacted to the situation.
- Describe a conflict you had with your colleague. How did you solve it?
- Describe a situation when you did not agree with the opinion (or decision) of your superior, and knew that they were wrong. What did you do?
- Describe a situation when you faced a particularly demanding problem or challenge in your personal life. How did that affect you in your job?
- Give me an example of a time when you had to explain something fairly complex or technical to a frustrated client or colleague. How did you get your message over?
- Describe a situation when you were under pressure in work.
